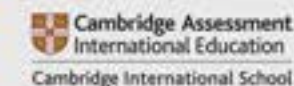

OUR UNIQUE TEACHING SYSTEMS

The quality of cognitive skills we see in our children every day is something that we are extremely proud of. The resources our children use are truly world-class and are of an exceptionally high standard plus we use first class assessment systems ensuring we continuously achieve exceptionally high standards.

We were the first school in the entire ASEAN, Indo-China Region to offer complete digital education in all major subjects. Our classrooms are equipped with high-speed internet, lessons are delivered using the latest Digital Smart Board technology. Students from KG2 onwards use iPads, for learning, assessments and examinations. This means our children can reach resources that 99% of the children in the world don't have available to them.

This ensures high-quality lesson delivery in the classroom, and teachers are supplied with an unlimited amount of differential resources that cover every single academic expectation, readily available at his/her fingertips.

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

The Taunggyi International School philosophy of pre-school education is a blend of personal and academic focus. The child's personal development is our primary concern. For this reason, children in our pre-schools know that they are safe, cared for and loved. Having established a safe and nurturing environment, each child is able to explore, play, identify with their peers and begin to learn to follow rules, be respectful of others and acquire the rudimentary skills of taking care of themselves and their environment.

All our pre-schools are bright, clean and colorful. With lots of outdoor activities, events, presentations and excursions, where a young child's enquiring mind is continually stimulated. We know pre-school children need to develop motor skills with lots of hands-on practice which we provide. Physical development and coordination are targeted through co-curricular activities such as Physical Education, Wushu, and Dance.

There are educational toys and games to further develop their enquiring minds, and an "early years" computer-based language program. In addition to our fluency lab for language learning, our children enjoy learning 'early years' English and Chinese with native speakers.

With around 800 Pre-schoolers attending our various pre-school centers which is by far the largest amount compared to other private international schools in Myanmar. Our children not only progress with 3 languages from the beginning but also achieve at least 2 years higher reading levels as reading is our first and foremost priority in the pre-schools.

PRIMARY EDUCATION

During these critical years a child develops the tools he/she will need throughout his/her life with our Primary Program. It is throughout these years that children begin to learn critical thinking in organized settings. These are the years when children begin to acquire academic planning skills, learn to organize and manage their time and the resources available to them.

Students begin to develop their own responses and solutions to problems and questions. Students continue to develop their brains and bodies with Physical Education, Martial Arts, Dance and outdoor activities and playtime. These years continue to be stimulating and rich, with excursions, field trips, overnight camps, performances and student-led assemblies as well as enriching their lives with continued learning of their culture, history and religion.

These years also see the curricular introduction of ICT, original and creative writing, Kindle® readers and home assignments. Academic rigor and critical thinking increases in these years with the introduction of a rigorous testing schedule designed to prepare students early on for their future Cambridge Primary Checkpoint Exams.

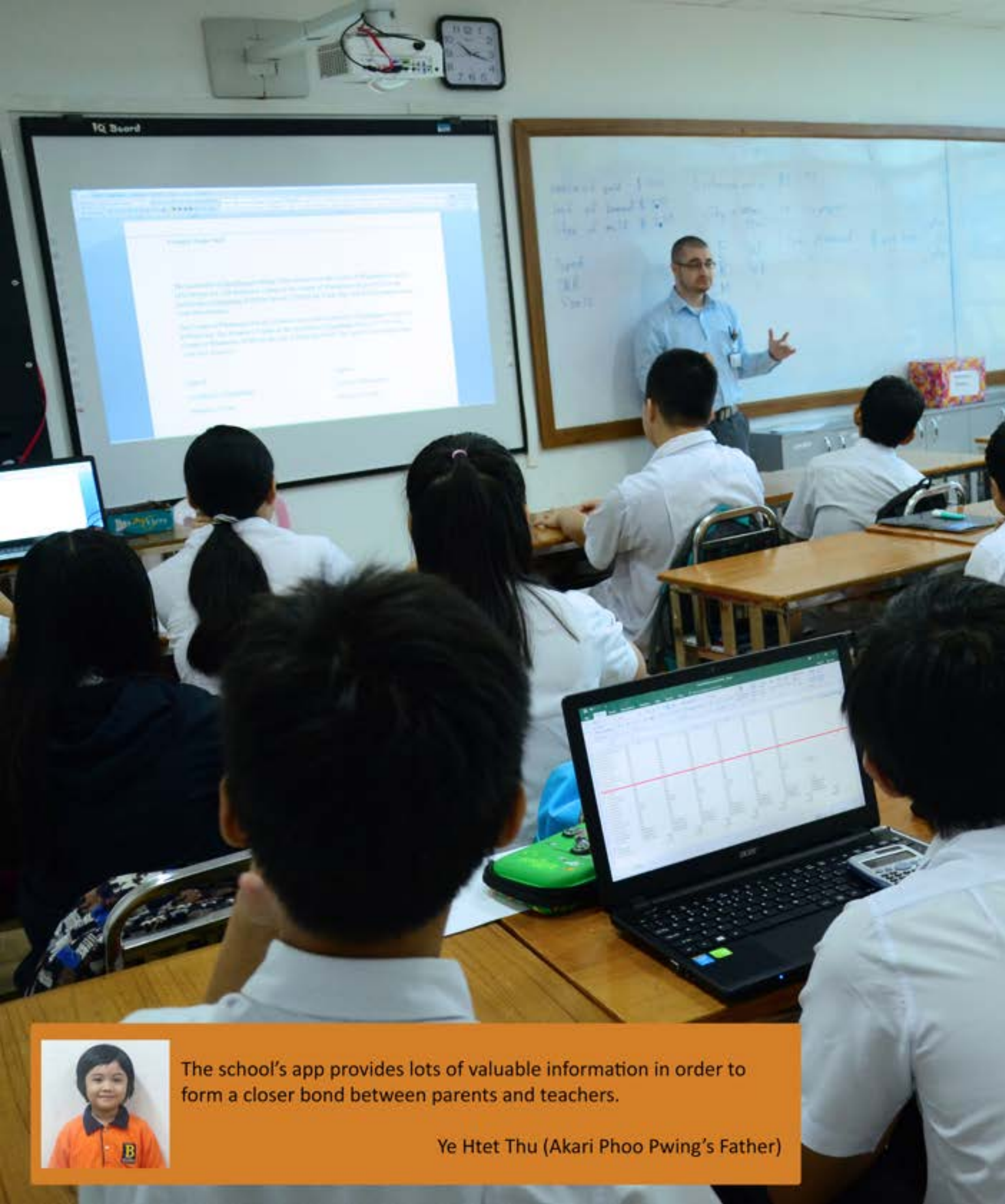

SECONDARY AND UPPER SECONDARY EDUCATION

Taunggyi International School offers secondary education in line with a modern up to date curriculum and facilities delivered by highly qualified and experienced international and local teachers that meet and in some cases, exceed the latest Cambridge standards.

Arriving at the Secondary level is a monumental and meaningful step for every student. This stage presents a growing awareness and sets in motion, an understanding of the world around them, and their own place in it. With sharpened cognitive, evaluative, demonstrative, and social skills, students gain lifelong tools that will carry them far into their chosen future in academia and/or beyond.

Our secondary schools have been designed to exhibit the best of our student's talents, skills, and abilities in all areas, and to challenge them to go beyond what is expected in many other schools. Our philosophy of education at the secondary level is one that expects students to intellectually confront assumptions, think for themselves, arrive at creative solutions and constantly question the environment around them.

Their academic career in our pre-school and primary schools prepares them to make significant contributions to their community. They understand the importance of charity, humility, and independence. They have learned to distinguish right from wrong, put others first, and share resources. They have a curiosity and respect for the diverse world around them.

In secondary they are expected to demonstrate their commitment to our school's outcomes by sharing them with the community both locally and at large. Their written work is expected to reflect these values and their examinations require that they defend their opinions without recourse to rote responses. In sum, we teach them to be able to express themselves in humane, respectful and intellectual ways.

21ST CENTURY CURRICULUM

Our idea of education is to empower the students in order to take care of their education and their future life by themselves. We believe in education for life and not just for passing examinations. We take a holistic approach to learning where the students will develop the skills that they need to have forever in their life such as intellectual, emotional, social, and physical, leadership and spiritual sides of them.

We follow the teaching techniques on the lines with 'Sheltered Instructions Observation Protocol' model and we further improve it with what is necessary in our classrooms. Every classroom is student-centered with 90% of play based activities wherein the students are empowered with the ownership of their own every day lessons from a micro level, individual-skill by skill.

Though the school adopts Cambridge International Curriculum, however, the school keep this as a minimum framework but the best out of everything from the world. Our English Language Development is something that we are proud of: Starting from a world-class Phonics and language and literacy program that is further supported by Guided Reading Development and a Brain Plasticity program called Fast ForWord and Reading Mastery.

Reading and Writing is well developed in the foundational years itself. Reading Wonders, the world's most comprehensive English Language Arts program is followed at Primary and Houghton Mifflin's Collections at the Secondary level. These programs are and can run only by experts in the field and need hours of training and practice followed by feedback.

All our Math and Science programs are adaptive and students can move with their own skill levels. STEAM, the integrated skill development of Science, Technology, and Engineering and Math fields is our major attraction with more than 720 projects from Nursery to Advanced levels.



21ST CENTURY CLASSROOM

Our kindergarten classrooms are filled with books, blocks, puppets, dress-up clothes, props, art supplies, manipulatives for counting and categorizing.

These classrooms are organized into multiple learning areas such as a book area, kitchen area, computer area, carpet area for playing with puzzles, blocks, reading, sharing, singing, carry out discussions, music area, and science and life-skills area.

More importantly, they have interactive smart boards which are child-friendly and supported with unlimited resources and very useful software's.

All our Primary and Secondary Classrooms are equipped with state of art technologies, such as Smart boards, visualizers, display equipment and they are all connected to a high-speed online server, as this makes the resources in the classrooms unlimited.

Other than this, there are many tools that are handy to keep the students engage through meaningful activities. Every student is a 'smart' student in our school; much of their homework is on the digital platform, completed on their iPad/tablet on which they have 24-hour access to their textbooks, homework, assessments, additional references and thousands of videos and support materials. Thus, knowledge is not the monopoly of the teachers, but the students have ownership of their learning.

21ST CENTURY STUDENTS

As the children of 21st century are digital-native, they are naturally familiar with simulative activities that modern day digital equipment offers because of their environment.

This makes the challenges tougher for the teachers to keep them engaged. The teacher must be an entertaining educator who is versatile using all the tools and technologies and have to upkeep their skills, knowledge and developments constantly.

Critical thinking and problem solving, collaboration across networks and leading by influence, agility and adaptability, initiative and entrepreneurship, effective oral and communication skills, accessing and analyzing information, curiosity and imagination are the seven expected survival skills to be mastered, to face the competitive 21st century students.

It is said that in the next 20 years, 60% of the jobs that are available today will not be in existence anymore. To prepare the next generation for such a future it is important they understand that challenges are a part of life and overcoming them helps build resilience and stronger character.



STEAM INTEGRATION

The 21st century skills that are required by the students can be classified into 3 categories, the first one being, fundamental Literacies development, such as Literacy, numeracy, scientific literacy, ICT literacy, financial literacy, cultural and civic literacy development. These are the core skills to face everyday tasks.

The second category being competencies development, this includes development of critical thinking, creativity, communication and collaboration.

The third category of development is developing character qualities which will help students approach their changing environment, these skills are developing curiosity, initiative, persistence, grit, adaptability, leadership and social/cultural awareness.

Competencies and character development is a complex area and this is where STEAM education comes very handy. As a hands-on, project-oriented program with problem solving as a main focus, it catches the attention of the students very quickly and helps to achieve the outcomes.

Students also learn how to integrate the skills they learn in their fundamental literacies development. Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Technology disciplines along with creativity are integrated and given to them as projects to solve. Each year the school has at least 720 projects. A student goes through a minimum of 40 hands-on projects every year and through them they develop all the expected skills.

We were one of the first schools in the whole world to implement STEAM into the curricula. It is a lot of work, and the additional manpower and skills required for this exercise is enormous. The school sees this as the future of education.





PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR THE 21ST CENTURY

Modern day teachers and school leaders must be innovative in their jobs as the expectation in the classroom is increasingly higher in terms of classroom language, student engagement, planning and preparation, setting up a conducive learning environment, planning assessments, communication with families and peers as well as incorporating and managing excursions, functions and special events.

A teacher plays multiple roles on a daily basis, from a simple foster parent to a college career guidance counselor. In the past teachers used to think that what they were teaching would be good enough for their students to pass their exams and to qualify them to get a job. These days getting a student ready for university or employability alone is not enough, as they must train them to love lifelong learning and to grow academically and emotionally. Modern day digital options literally make everything available to them at their fingertips, what makes a teacher necessary in the classroom is their 'human touch'

As we learn more about the mind and how people learn in an ever-changing world the way we teach and educate students is also an evolutionary process both in and outside of the classroom. In order to develop themselves in multiple disciplines, today's teachers must spend even more hours in professional development than they did in the past. The foundation pillar of our school is its training plans and programs, the school fosters training as a way of life, making 180 hours of training per year compulsory for every teacher in multiple areas.

STUDENT EMPOWERMENT

As personal growth is a top priority for the Taunggyi International School family, we offer several opportunities for students and teachers to develop their interpersonal and intrapersonal skills. Student and teacher empowerment is achieved in the school through events in which we bring in international motivational self-development guest speakers from around the world, which further enhances their self-esteem and leadership skills. Overnight camps with various themes are continuously empowering the students to become responsible citizens.

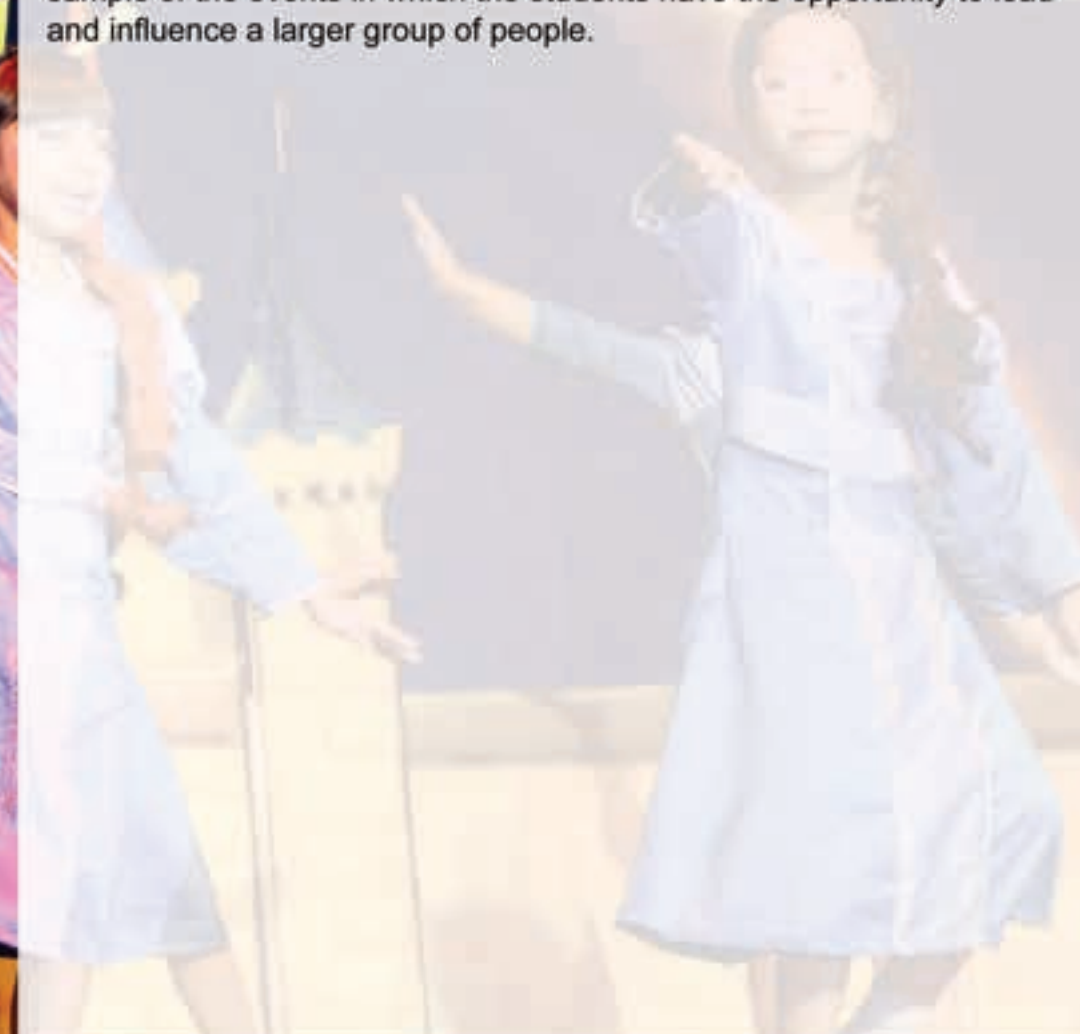




SHOWCASING FOR FOUNDATION BUILDING

ASSESSMENTS AND EXAMINATIONS



Our assessment system is very unique in that the four major assessments in the school every year is centrally prepared for all the schools, in order to bring fairness and self-evaluation.

Our assessment system is unique in that the assessments and examinations are centrally prepared and disseminated to each of the schools, providing a consistent and fair process.

Each school has the autonomy to self-evaluate and contribute to further development of these assessments.

Our German and Chinese education achievements of students are tested and certified by independent authorities such as the Goethe institute and Hanban Confucius Institute at the end of every year.

Students sit Primary checkpoint exams at the end of year 6, secondary checkpoint at the end of year 8 and IGCSE at year 10. Advanced subsidiary at year 11 and advanced levels at year 12 are some of the international testing that are offered and must be taken by students in the school. As a member of the Cambridge International Primary program from grade 1 to grade 7 all our tests are conducted as per CIP standards and assessments offered by them. This gives an exceptional trust for parents that their children's education is current and appropriate and carries validity across countries.

OUR YOUTH LEADERSHIP MOVEMENT

Taunggyi International School family places special importance on educating responsible future leaders of Myanmar. That is why we have introduced several projects that shape our students' civic responsibility, such as the Grow More Trees project and the Feed a hungry stomach project (providing lunch and medicine for patients in government hospitals); we have built schools in Rakhine state and other rural areas; visited and taught in orphanages; built toilets in government schools; and dug wells in monasteries. **Our Youth Leadership Movement** is a student organization responsible for charity projects and environmental campaigns in the school and general community making Myanmar a better place to live.

The **Youth Leadership Movement** was founded by a group of students when they came back from the Youth Environmental Summit in Singapore and wanted to apply what they learned in real life.

The program started with volunteer students cleaning up rubbish around the outside of the school compound during their spare weekend time. Later, they expanded the program to other townships and rural areas.

How do they raise funds?

They sell small items and food such as ice-cream and popcorn during school functions. Companies and organisations are welcome to donate money and materials to support these worthy causes.
